Beautiful and completely new **2 bedroom apartment for rent in Sant Gervasi** with 55 m2 + 20 m2 terrace in Francesc Macia Sq and close to the city center. It is easily accessible public transport. It has a living-dinning room and a fully equipped kitchen with washer-dryer machine. There is a double bedroom with closet, one single bedroom and a complete bathroom with shower. Also the apartment has air conditioning and heating by ducts and a big terrace in the top of the roof. The building has an elevator.

Originally it was a small farming village. In the tenth century it became a part of Sarria, and in 1714 it was declared an autonomous municipality. Finally, in 1897 it was annexed to Barcelona. That was when the area of Sant Gervasi was discovered by the Catalan bourgeoisie, who began their first developments there. In just over 50 years, it became a bustling residential area with manor houses, holiday villas and monasteries

The unique feel of the Bonanova area is distinguished by the atmosphere of the past. Notable sites include the Rotonda building, the gardens designed by Rubio, the Science Museum and the old Casacubierta factory designed by the famous Catalan architect Josep Domench i Estapà.
